TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This tournament will be USBC and TNBA Certified.
2. This tournament is open to all USBC and TNBA members. **NO CARDS** will be sold at the tournament. All participants must have both cards available prior to bowling; otherwise, they will not be permitted to participate. Both cards must be presented during check-in, which will take place at the Bowler's assigned lanes. No temporary cards will be accepted.
3. PBA or WPBA members **WILL NOT** be allowed to participate in this tournament. Past members who have not held a card within the past two years will be allowed to bowl.
4. The reserve entry deadline is MARCH 14, 2026. Entries will also be accepted via email at tnbagatorcitytournament@gmail.com until Midnight on March 14, 2026. Entries and/or fees must be postmarked by March 14, 2026, in order to be accepted. The full amount of fees must accompany the completed mailed entry forms, and fees for any entry forms received via email must be received by the entry deadline of March 14, 2026, for the entry to be honored. Walk-in entries will be accepted if lanes are available.
5. **PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY REASON.** The total entry fee in the form of a Money Order, Bank check, Certified check, or Zelle must accompany the completed application.
6. This is a handicap mixed (teams/doubles) event with optional Singles. All teams and mixed doubles events must consist of at least one female and one male. Crossover Mixed Doubles will also be available during the Doubles event. The handicap for this tournament shall be 90% of 220.
7. All teams must enter the handicap division at \$140/team. Teams may enter the scratch team event for an additional \$40 (\$180 for both divisions).
8. All bowlers must enter the handicap doubles event if bowling doubles at \$70/pair. Doubles teams may enter the scratch doubles event for an additional \$20 (\$90 for both divisions). Crossover mixed doubles will be allowed, while bowling mixed doubles at \$20/pair/division (\$40/pair for both divisions).
9. Multiple entries are permitted for the mixed teams/doubles event; three (3) players on the same team will be allowed to re-enter the team event, and the same doubles partners will be allowed to re-enter but may only cash once using their highest doubles score.
10. Bowlers may enter the singles handicap and/or scratch event at \$20/division (\$40 for both divisions). Multiple entries will be permitted for the singles event and will be accepted until 30 minutes before the scheduled time to bowl. The individual Bowler's team event score will count as his/her singles score. Bowlers will only be allowed to cash once using their highest score in the singles event. There will be a separate Men and Women division for singles.
11. Entrants must use their 2024-2025 USBC COMPOSITE average with at least 36 GAMES listed on Bowl.com. If a bowler does not have a 2024-2025 average, he/she must use the highest 2025-2026 league average with at least 36 games listed on Bowl.com. The Bowler must enter the tournament with a 220 average if none of the above. The USBC 10-pin average rule **WILL BE APPLIED**. Any bowler that won \$600 or more in our 2025 tournament with at least 12 tournament games bowled may be subject to an average adjustment applied to their entering average in accordance with USBC Rule 319e at the discretion of the Tournament Director. All averages will be verified again before the final payout.
12. All bowlers, regardless of average, must comply with Rule 319d (Reporting Prior Prize Winnings) from CERTIFIED AND NON-CERTIFIED tournaments. Any bowler who has qualified within the last 12-month period for the prize: 1) \$300 or more in any event; 2) Total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament; 3) Total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12 months; must report the name of the tournament, amount of prize and ACTUAL SCORE BOWLED to qualify for a prize. Failure to comply is cause for a forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.
13. It shall be each Bowler's responsibility to verify his/her average for accuracy (whether originally submitted by the Bowler, his/her team captain, or others). Failure to do so will result in disqualification. If an entrant submits an average higher than his/her true average, he/she must live with a lesser handicap, and no additional pins will be given to him/her. If an entrant submits an average less than his/her true average, he/she will be disqualified and therefore forfeit all prize money won. To avoid disqualification, entrants must make average corrections during check-in.
14. **NO POSITION LINEUP CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED.** Lineups will be set in the order names are listed on the entry form submitted by the Team Captain. Substitutes will be permitted at the Team Captain's discretion and must bowl in the original entrant's position. All rules and regulations apply to substitutes. Once a substitute has started to bowl, the substitute must finish the event being bowled. The Team Captain must submit all substitute changes to the Tournament Director's Office at least 30 minutes before scheduled squad time. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
15. The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify any entrant not in compliance with the rules of the tournament, TNBA, and USBC. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of the GATOR CITY SENATE TNBA Tournament shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all prizes, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
16. Official lane assignments will be posted near the tournament office and front entrance one hour before the time scheduled to bowl.
17. Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled, with zero being given for each frame missed. If a team refuses to start because a full lineup is not present, they shall receive zero for all frames which they decline to bowl. No blind score shall be permitted, and a bowler must bowl with and on the same lanes and at the same time his/her team bowls.
18. Provisional ball or frame will be used in situations where foul or legality of pinfall cannot be immediately resolved.
19. After an entry has been received, no fees shall be refunded except in a dire emergency, such as strikes, lockouts, fires, etc., over which management has no control.
20. The prize fee will be returned 100% for each event collected. There will be at least one (1) prize for every six (6) entries for both divisions (handicap & scratch). Prizes will be awarded by the total pinfall plus handicap for the handicap division and the total pinfall in the scratch division. If the Bowler loses a prize check, there will be a \$25 fee for replacing lost checks.
21. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final on any and all disputes unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
